



Dollar a cup coffee – what a delight!

of 100 cups per week. If a machine is no longer required it is taken away but there are no penalties or charges.

For firms with no formal café, Xpresso Delight provides a great service but for schools, sports clubs and community groups they are a profitable fundraiser. By charging more than the \$1 per cup anything extra can go towards projects, equipment or other uses.

Coming from a background in sales and marketing, Isabel says Xpresso Delight is so successful because

there is no initial outlay for clients. The machines come with a milk cooler and even a chocolate shaker and with a weekly service included nothing could be simpler or more convenient.
